

# The good feeling of being dressed just right

To help prepare your holiday wardrobe, we have set a simple dress code that will allow you to explore the resort's various dining destinations and entertainment options while always being perfectly dressed.

From breakfast until the sun sets in the horizon, you can make yourself comfortable in resort casual whilst dining and exploring around the resort. We kindly ask that you always wear a top (T-shirt, polo shirt, tunic, etc.) and dry trousers/shorts/skirts when seated in the restaurants. In the evening, dressing in 'Evening Wear,' 'Elegant Casual,' or 'Formal Attire' would be preferred to enhance the overall resort atmosphere.





### **FORMAL ATTIRE**

Formal attire in a resort setting is perfect for weddings and other special events.

Whilst, resort dress is more relaxed and similar to what you might wear to a cocktail party. Men can opt for a light suit, though a nice button-up linen shirt and trousers is a nice alternative. Dress shoes are recommended over tennis shoes or sandals.

Women have more options, including full-length dresses, gowns, or a nice trouser suit or skirt with a top.

All outfits should be paired with a nice pair of flats or heels.



### RESORT EVENING WEAR

During the evening, for dinner at the resort, men should wear dressier shorts, trousers, or nice jeans with a polo or collared shirt.

T-shirts, sleeveless shirts, and simple shorts are not typically acceptable. Women can choose a casual dress or pair a top with nice jeans, trousers, or a skirt.

Both men and women may opt for elegant sandals or closed-toed shoes, while flip-flops should be avoided.



## **ELEGANT CASUAL**

Elegant casual, also known as 'casual elegance,' is a step above evening wear, typically similar to something you would wear to an upscale restaurant. For this dress code, men are expected to wear a long-sleeve dress shirt with trousers, and dressier shoes—non-transparent outer, no shorts, T-shirts, or sandals. Women can wear skirts or trousers with a nice top or a dress complemented with a stylish pair of heels or flats.



# **RESORT CASUAL**

The resort casual or informal atmosphere is similar to what you would wear to popular breakfast, brunch, and lunch spots.
Please refrain from wearing wet bathing suits or shorts, as well as being topless, while visiting our bars and restaurants.
Non-transparent swimsuit cover-ups, jeans, capris, and shorts with a T-shirt or polo shirt are appropriate. Tennis shoes, trainers, and sandals are all acceptable, and flip-flops could be an option for this relaxed dress code.
